There'll be demonstrations with the Jaws of Life, the Police Dog Displays, the Police fitness course to try, a kitchen fire display, rapid response vehicles, mines rescue display and lots of bubbles for the kids to 'get lost' in.

There'll also be lots of interactive displays and information. Add competitions, fire engine rides, food and refreshments and I think you'll agree it's going to be a busy time between 10am and 2pm.
