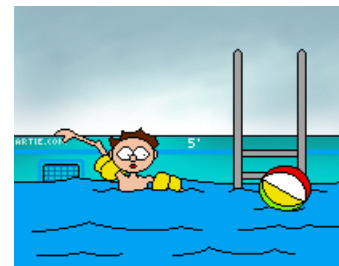

CHRISTMAS FLOAT

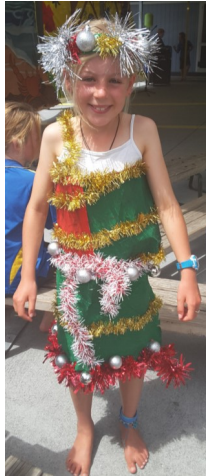
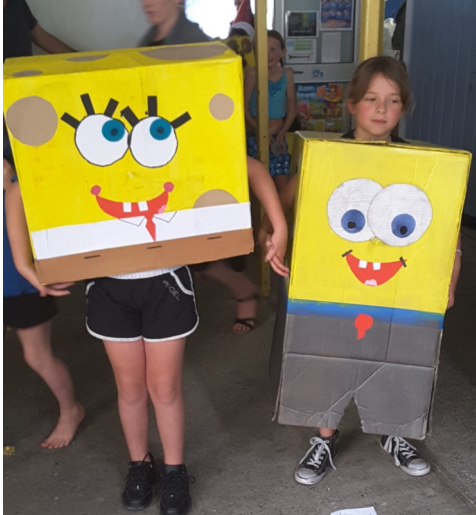
