START/FINISH TIMES

The start time for each school day is 9am. Our school is open from 8am. School finishes at 3pm. The school bus leaves at 2.50pm. If your child is a bus student they will be placed on the bus unless the office has been notified otherwise.

Children need to wear hats when outside in term 1 & 4. These are available from the office and are \$8 each. The hats are kept at school but sent home at the end of term for cleaning. No hat means the child does not go out in the sun at morning tea and lunchtime. No other hats are allowed at school.

SCHOOL DONATION
