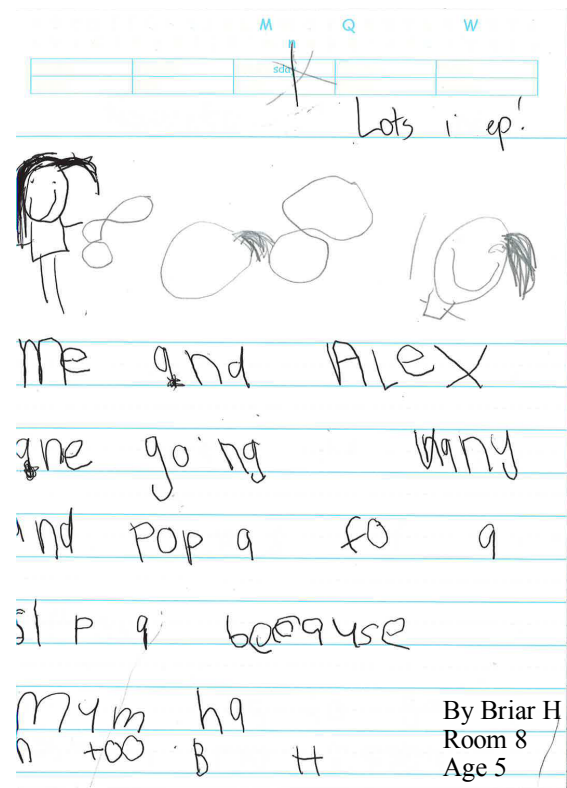
## Waihi East School Banking
