## PB4L

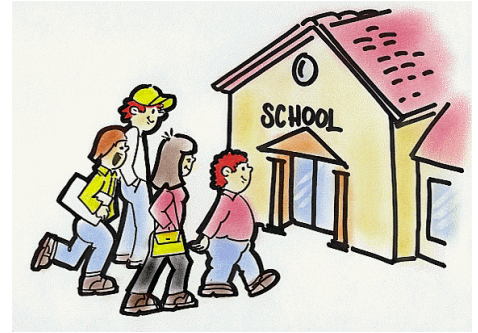

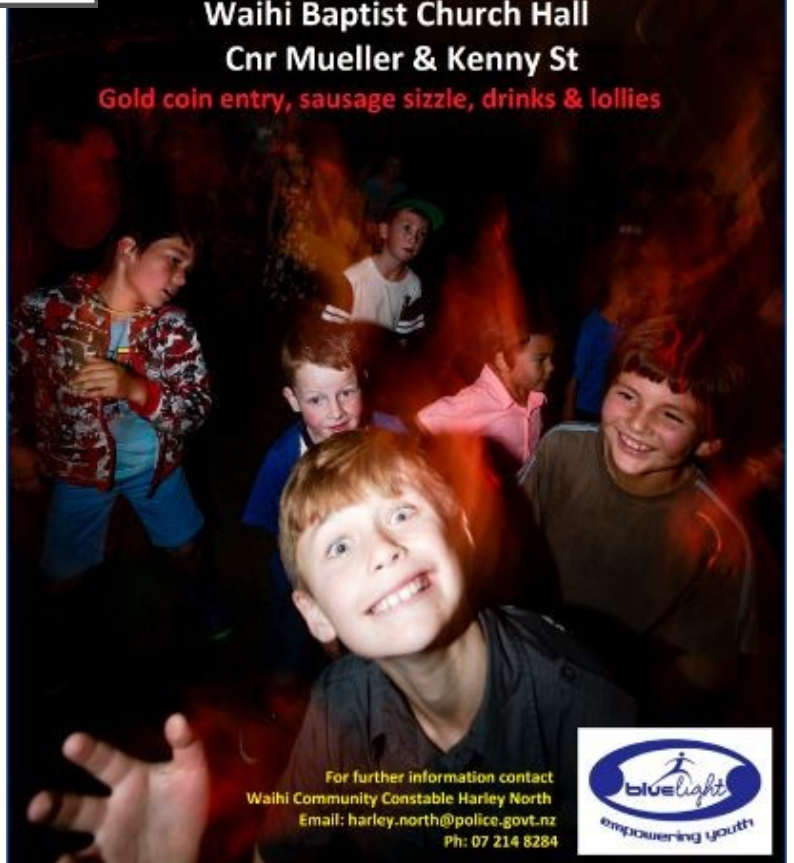

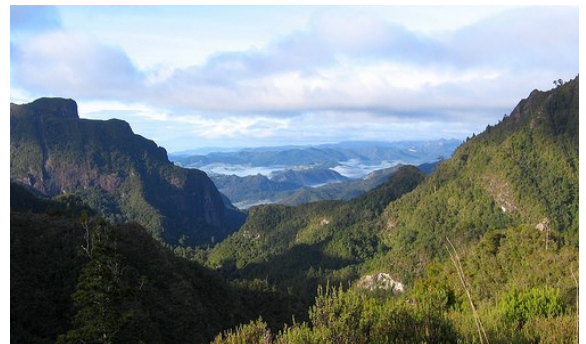
